NOTE FROM FATHER...

You are beloved! Yesterday, on the Feast of the Queenship of Mary, 5 Handmaids of the Heart of Jesus Sisters in New Ulm took their first vows! What a glorious celebration, even in this time of CoVid! We had 2 priest ordinations in June. See the Church being renewed right before our eyes here in New Ulm! Jesus is re-building His Church! In our Gospel, Jesus asks, "Who do you say that I am?" Simon replies: "You are the Christ." Jesus then gives Simon Peter the keys to the Kingdom "You are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of hell will not prevail against it." These are powerful words of Jesus. First – he calls it 'my church'. Some people want to tear down the church, for reasons of their own belief or because of the abuses that have happened. They say the church is not important, only Jesus. But Jesus calls it 'my church'. We are His Church. The Church is the Body of Christ – The Church IS Jesus, our Head, together with all those who belong to Him. How our world needs the presence of Jesus that we bring! Another blessing of CoVid is that the people of the Church have to examine our hearts: Do I go to Church just out of duty, or do I truly desire to go to Church, to be a part of the Body of Christ? Since the obligation has been lifted (only for reasons of CoVid), people are only coming if they actually want to be there. This is also a moment of renewal of His Church. When people really want to be there, nothing will keep them away. They will start returning, even if there is no obligation. One day the obligation will be put back in place, rightly so (Sioux Falls already did this). I pray you will come back renewed, coming because you want to, not just because you have to. You are beloved!
