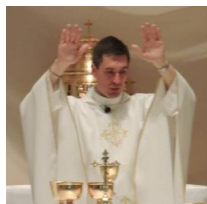
I would like to sincerely thank Father Denny Labat for his time here. He has been such a gracious spiritual father to the parishes here. I am pleased to be following in his footsteps.
