## NOTE FROM FATHER...

This is my last weekend here at the Apostles Peter and Paul AFC. When I came here to be pastor of the Apostles Peter and Paul AFC last June 4th, I shared with you that Bishop LeVoir had appointed me as temporary pastor for about one year until a permanent pastor could be appointed. I assumed that it would likely be until the regular priest moves at the end of June each year. I have loved serving as a priest of the Diocese of New Ulm since 1974.

As you have heard already Fr. Craig Timmerman has been appointed to serve as pastor of our AFC beginning on July 1st. Some people think that I am going to Marshall to retire. I have been assigned to return back to Marshall to serve 5 parishes in that area along with 2 other priests. I will be a senior associate pastor serving full-time.

As I reflect on these last 13 months, they have gone by quickly. A transition in pastoral leadership is never easy, especially when it happens unexpectedly. It is not easy for me or any priest to change parishes. As a diocesan priest I promised obedience to the bishop. I have always said yes to the assignment the bishop has asked me to take. Sometimes these assignments were not what I would have chosen. Sometimes it was among my options. In June 2018, I had been assignment to my home area and assumed that I would serve there until I retired. This assignment to be temporary pastor at St. Peter and Nicollet was a surprise. Even so, I said yes. This assignment has been a good assignment for me and hopefully for the people of this AFC. There were some challenges and many blessings.

I thank God for the many opportunities to get to know and work with the people of St. Peter and St. Paul parishes. We did make progress in a number of areas and also had a few surprises thrown at us. The toughest one was the forced closing of the churches



because of the covid-19 virus from mid-March to the end of May. As I move back to Marshall, I will keep all of you in my prayers. Your new pastor, Fr. Craig



Timmerman, has been a pastor with Catholic schools and brings good experience as a pastor. Besides, he is a good Belgian priest like I am. I wish everyone in the Apostles Peter and Paul Area Faith Community God's special blessing. I will miss you.
