**A NOTE FROM FATHER**

We have finally received direction from our bishop about the phased opening of our churches again. The guidelines for the phased reopening of public worship are the same for all six dioceses in Minnesota. There are **three phases**. During these phases we must maintain strict adherence to the guidelines for social distancing and sanitization. **Those over age 65 will be strongly encouraged not to attend.** As circumstances allow, a visit from a priest, deacon, or extraordinary minister of Holy Communion to bring them the Eucharist may be possible. Also, anyone showing any symptoms of sickness, or anyone who has a household member who is sick or showing symptoms of sickness should not come to Church.

**Phase 1** – begins on May 4. We can now have our church or chapel open for prayer during the day. Funerals with 10 or fewer people are possible. Confessions will be available - at St. Peter on Wednesday and Saturday at 1:00pm; at St. Paul on Wednesday and Saturday at 11:00am. During this time, we will be preparing for the time when we can begin celebrating Mass again. **Everyone must sanitize their hands when coming into church. Everyone (except children under age 2) should wear a cloth face cover.**

**Phase 2** – begins on May 18. We will be able to have Mass with limited number of people (1/3 of seating capacity). The **obligation to attend Mass** is still dispensed by the bishops. There will be directions posted for procedures during Mass.

**Phase 3** will allow for larger celebrations. There is no date for this phase yet.

I will be mailing a letter to all parishioners in both parishes with more details about the protocols we will be incorporating on May 18th when we are able to start celebrating public Mass. Keep praying for quick recovery from this pandemic.
